


SHOW & TELL - January 2023 - Electrical or Electronic Items or Gadgets

John Jackson - displayed his RR-CirKits Loco Buffer with a Windows CD, Manual and hardware






Greg Rich, MMR, scratch built this store from an internet photo of a store in Battle Creek. He used basswood and graphics he downloaded.

Dave Thornton - brought a "blast from the past!" He says it's been sitting in his basement for 40+ years. Throttles and control panel from 1950s?




Larry Wolohon, MMR - displayed his current project - An O Scale Tanget three dome tank car, decaled for Petroleum Products.





Jim Zinser, MMR, brought a saw mill sound board to be installed in a yet-to-be-built saw mill on his layout.


Dan Mitzel uses a RailLogicTechnologies signal tester to build his signaling system
